Dasvandh Network (DVN) was founded 11 years ago with the mission to inspire Sikhs to give Dasvandh in support of high activism aligned with Sikh values. Through DVN, we address challenges facing Sikhs and our broader communities by serving as a centralized point of fundraising and sustainability.

More than a decade later, our online giving platform continues to grow its impact by connecting more and more donors with organizations that are working towards the betterment of society. With Guru's kirpa, 2022 marked our strongest year yet. We helped raise \$2.1M from 3,200 donors from 15 countries & 50 U.S. states & territories. We also distributed \$575K to organizations via grants. These funds went to 64 unique organizations working across a variety of crucial issue areas.

This growth was largely due to the investments we are making into staff, operations, marketing, and partnerships. In 2023 and beyond, we are dedicated to continuing to invest in the powerful work of our partner organizations, particularly through digital avenues that continue to emerge as part of our every day. We aim to continue strengthening our technology and governance to further facilitate giving.

We have only scratched the surface of reaching our vision of having Sikh families all over the world give dasvandh regularly. There are so many more organizations out there that can leverage our platform. We are excited to reach new milestones and amplify incredible work. We are looking forward to receiving continued support from our donors on this collective journey of growth.







As our community grows, so does the need of the 70+ nonprofit partners on our platform. Monthly donations are a great way to support and sustain the initiatives that align with donors' values.


# With this in mind, we built a new product called AutoDasvandh


### IMPACT TESTIMONIALS



Our annual board meeting takes place in September. This past year, it took place in Dallas, Texas and we welcomed one new board member.

In addition to building the strategic vision for the platform, the board also issued grants for larger Sikh-led nonprofits from board contributions. In 2022, we gave \$575K to 9 Sikh-led nonprofits further along in their organizational journey. This puts the total grant giving to \$6M+ since this program was started.
