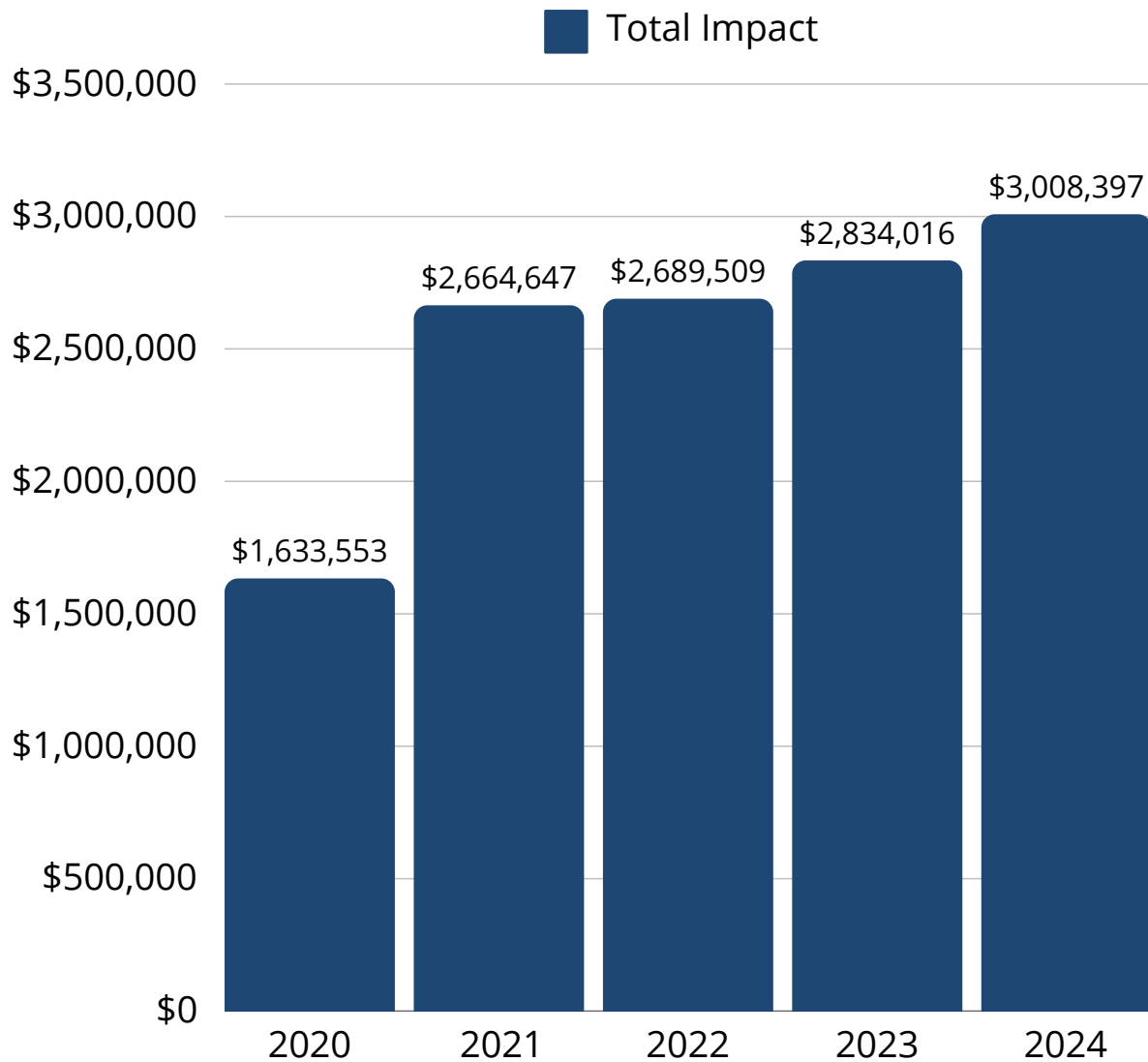

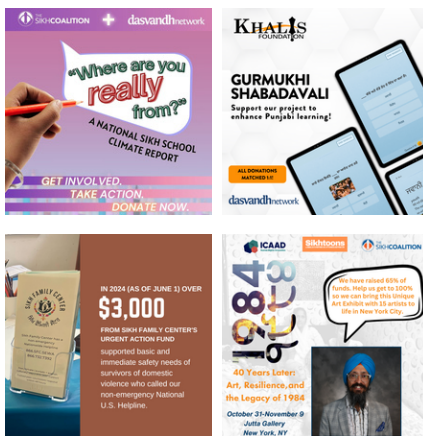
DasvandhWeek

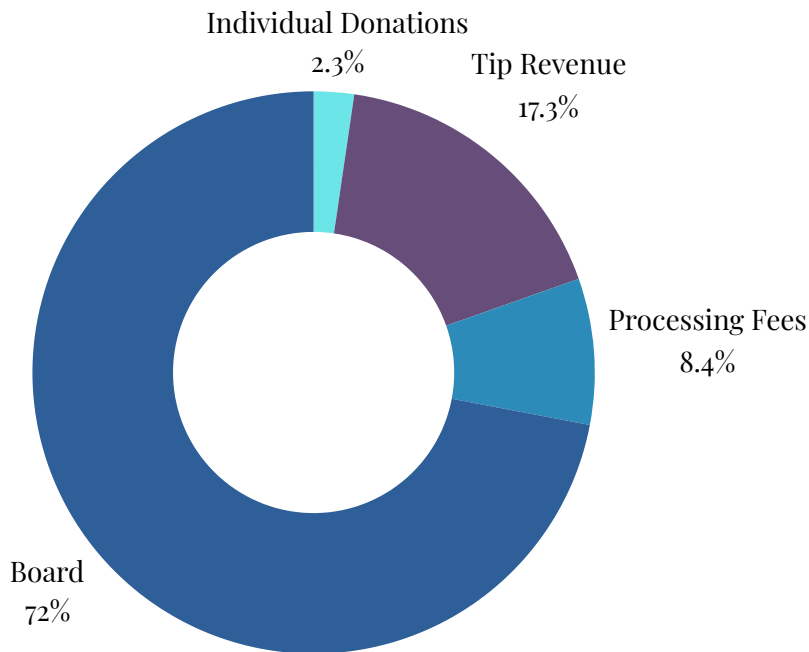

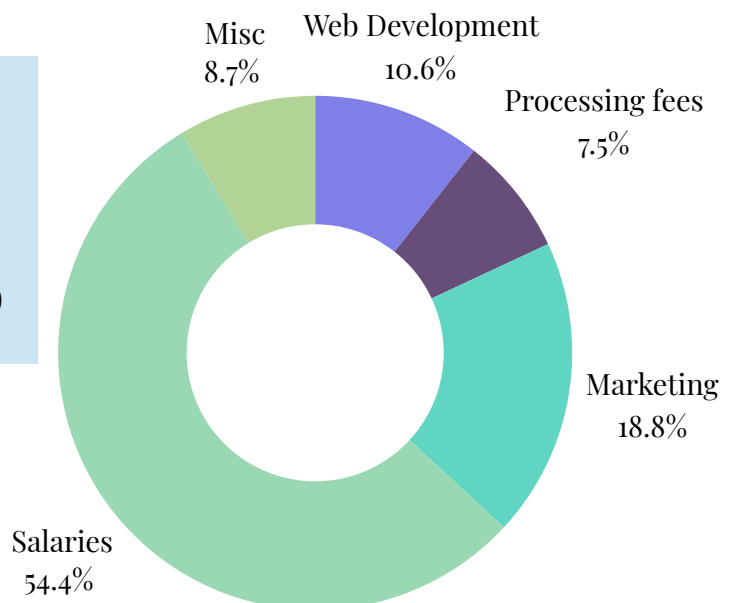
Operations Income

Beyond shaping the strategic vision for Dasvandh Network, the board allocated grants to more established Sikh-led nonprofits using contributions from board members. In 2024, we granted \$570,000 to 7 Sikh-led nonprofits that have progressed further in their organizational journey.
